

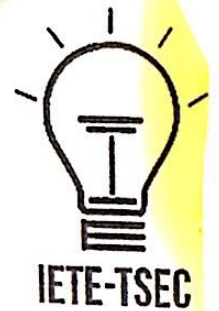

International Day of Yog (IDY'16) Report


Thadomal Shahani Engineering College (TSEC) observed "International Day of Yog"(IDY'16) today on 21/06/2016. National Service Scheme unit of the college, NSS-TSEC has conducted two days Common Yog Protocol (CYP) Training during June 20-21, 2016 on the occasion of worldwide celebration of IDY. This was initiated as Mr. Sachit G. Description of event:

OSCILLATION '17 was an annual intercollegiate techno fun festival which was held on 25th and 26th February, 2017 in Thadomal Shahani Engineering College, Bandra by the ISF here under the guidance of Dr. Tanuja Sarode. 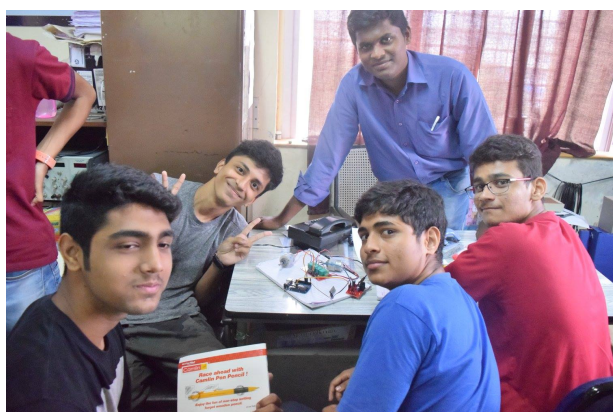
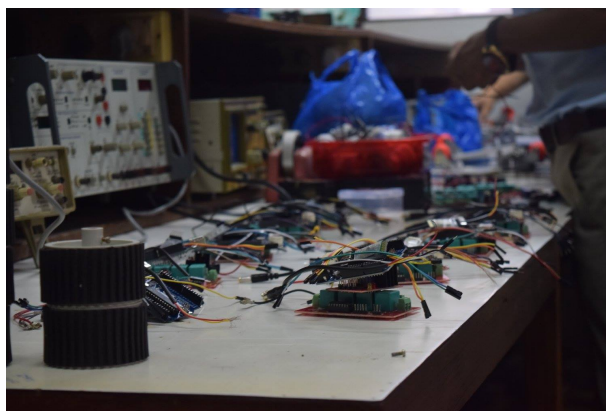

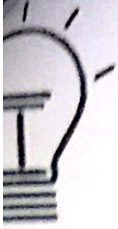

130 -150 registrations were received out of which approximately 120 students attended the workshop.



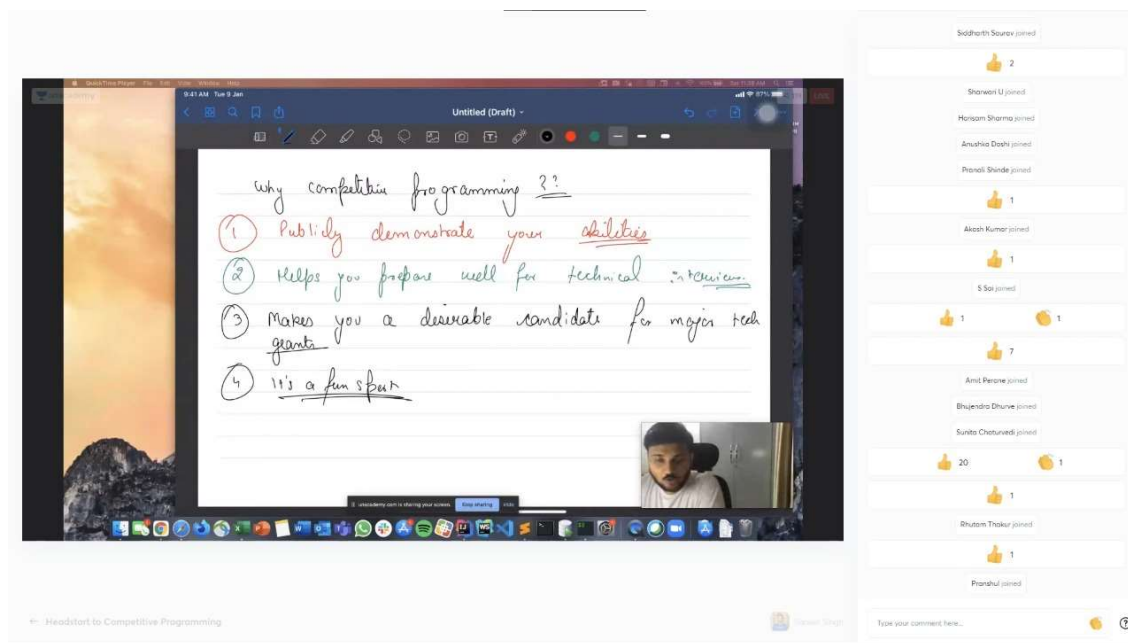

We received around 250 registrations but we had more than 350 students attending the workshop from all over India because it was conducted on Unacademy and was open for all



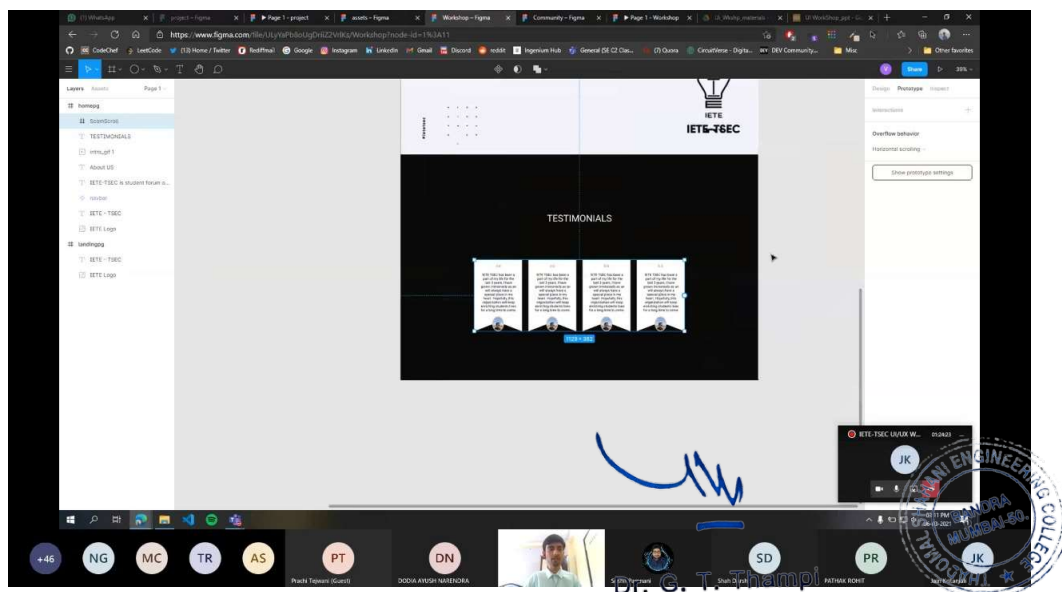

4. UI/UX Workshop

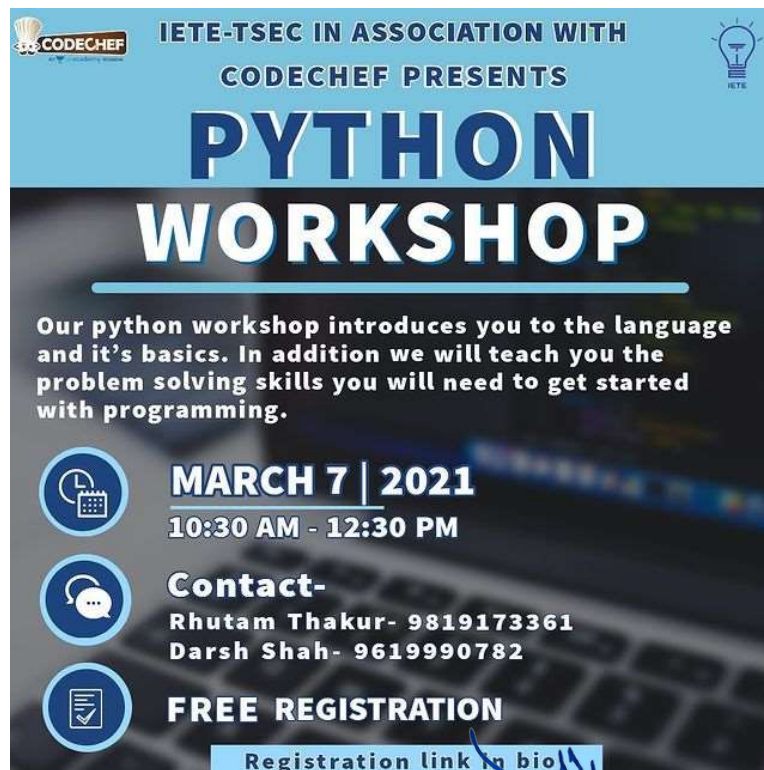
- **Speaker:**

- **Speaker:**

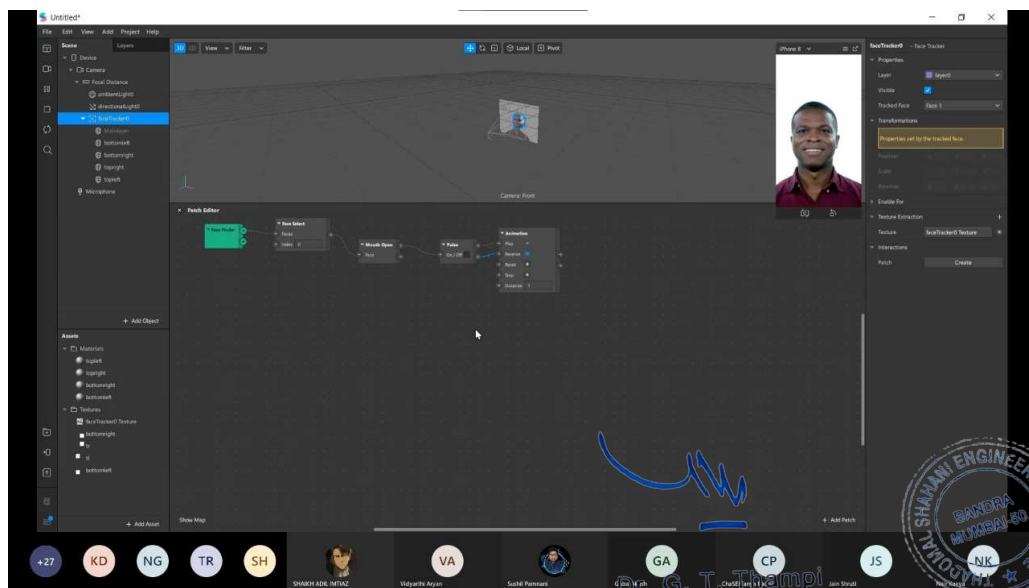
Kavya Nair and Akash Gaba (Junior Committee Members of IETE - TSEC)

Volunteers spread awareness on Linking Road on the 1st of September, standing with placards in unison with the entire country. The volunteers asked 100 people to give missed calls on 8000980009 respectively to support the campaign. They also attended an awareness event at NSCI Dome, Worli. Many famous celebrities came to the event to show their support and spread awareness about ISHA Foundation's Idea of Rally for rivers.

4. BEACH CLEANING DRIVE (01.09.2017)

This year NSS-TSEC celebrated Ganesh Chaturthi in a different way. 40-50 Volunteers joined in the cleanliness drive at Juhu Beach to clear out all the waste left behind after the festival.

5. FORT CLEANING (17.09.2017)

More than 100 volunteers had joined their hands for this. Garbage and waste products at Tourist spots decreases the value and importance of the national heritage spots. Volunteers picked up all the waste on route to the fort and then discarded it properly. This way the beauty of our national heritage was preserved.

6. JOY OF GIVING (25.09.2017(1 week) & 22.01.2018(1 week))

We collected dozens of books, pens and other toys and stationary, also we collected clothes for the underprivileged people and donated all the collected items to Mescos foundation for use by the needful. Around 80 volunteers helped us out.

7. BLOOD DONATION DRIVE (5.10.2017 & 07.02.2018)

More than 100 volunteers worked for both the Blood Donation Drives. With Lokmanya Tilaka MG Hospital and Tata Memorial Hospital DTM we collected 121 and 109 blood units to facilitate availability of blood for the cancer patients. We also got 170 people **checked for Thalassemia** out of which 4 were detected as Thalassemia minors by Transasia Bio-Medicals Ltd.

8. PAPER BAG PROJECT (25.08.2017 to 06.03.2018)

More than 20 Volunteers were involved in this project. With the aim of reducing plastic bags, we took the initiative to reuse old newspaper and make paper bags out of it which could be used to carry small items. We donated a couple 1000 paper bags in our local adopted area to vegetable vendors and grocery/medical shops.

1) Blockchain based E-Voting system

2) Social Cause

The Apprentice Project

Brief :

The Apprentice Project (TAP) team (alumni from IIM, TFI, and YIF) aims to build life skills in low-income kids by placing selected high-skilled volunteers in under-resourced schools for one year.

Currently, TAP works with 2500 students across 20+ schools with 200 facilitators.

Every Saturday for three hours the volunteers/facilitators mentor and teach in one of the following verticals based on their skills: Drama, Dance, Music, Public Speaking, Ultimate Frisbee, Electronics & Coding and Visual Arts.

Problem Statement:

1) Selection

The primary job of the TAP team is to select 250 facilitators from 2500 applications; for this, they currently use manual and excel based methods for sending emails and keeping information about the volunteer.

Create a volunteer management solution which can help the TAP team select the facilitators from the three-stage process so that all the emails are automated, and the serial numbers are generated automatically, etc.

The solution should make it easier for one person to manage everything, similar to CRM and ERP software.

2) Operation

For TAP's Operations team create a solution which can automate the communication with facilitators & provide a dashboard to the admin for facilitator management.

Currently, they use Google forms & sheets to collect data from facilitators, and admin staff manually do everything, including sending out Whatsapp messages.

TSEC Hacks 2021 Report

TSEC CodeCell, under the able guidance of Prof. Tasneem Mirza, hosted its annual flagship event **TSEC Hacks**, a **40 hour Online Hackathon**, that was conducted from the 26th of March to the 28th of March, 2021. The aim of this competition was to nurture innovation, motivate the participants to code, and foster healthy competition among the participants. The event had participants from different colleges, different streams and different undergraduate levels.

The 40 hour Hackathon was conducted as follows:


- **Day 1 (26th March)** - The Opening Ceremony began at 5 pm followed by the Problem Statement Explanation. The Coding Period for the participants began at 7 pm.
- **Day 2 (27th March)** - The Mentoring Sessions commenced at 10 am and went on till 8:30 pm where the students received guidance from the mentors as to how to improve upon their projects.
- **Day 3 (28th March)** - The Coding Round ended at 11 am, subsequently followed by the Phase 1 of judging. Phase 2 of Judging commenced at 3 pm, and after deliberation by the judges, the winners were announced at the Closing Ceremony.

The Hackathon being an online event was conducted on numerous platforms, particularly WhatsApp, Zoom and Discord. The teams consisted of 2-4 members, with each team having to pay a registration fee of ₹100 after getting shortlisted. The hackathon saw an overwhelming response with a total of 138 teams, consisting of aspiring students from 43 colleges, registering for the event. After much consideration and discussion, out of the 138 teams, 63 teams were shortlisted to compete in the hackathon.

The Publicity for the event was done on CodeCell social media handles (Instagram, LinkedIn, Facebook, Whatsapp), as well as on online event websites such as Dare2Compete. Information about the Hackathon was also circulated among various college groups, and the event was publicized by the CodeCell team in all classes of the Computer, IT, EXTC and BioMedical departments of TSEC.

The participants were required to upload their code to Github at the end of the Hackathon. To aid the participants who were unfamiliar with the framework, a 3-hour workshop on 'Git and Github' was conducted by Harsh Kapadia, a CodeCell committee

Your task is to create a **Cryptocurrency of your own** and demonstrate Cryptocurrency transactions using animations and dynamic visualisations (wherever applicable).

It should be capable of demonstrating 3 types of transactions:

1. Reward: Satoshi rewarded with 100 coins for mining a new block.

3. Fee: Mining fee of 1 for whoever mines the transaction (Satoshi in the example above).

It is necessary to address the following:

1. How is the value assigned?
2. How can people trust Cryptocurrency?

2. Fake Product Detection System:

There are many fake products that exist in the supply chain and to ensure the genuineness of the product, a system is needed. To check the genuineness of a product, the ownership history of the product needs to be maintained.

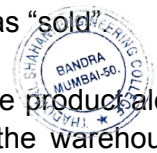
Every popular brand has fake manufacturers selling a counterfeited item at cheaper rates. Even the company experts may not be able to distinguish between fake ones and real ones.

Your task is to use Blockchain to find if a product is authentic or not.

The system should work as follows:

1. The manufacturer marks the goods with 2D barcode / QR Code and packs them.
2. At each stop along the supply chain, anyone handling the product will create a record on the blockchain before sending it along to the next link using the 2D Barcode / QR-code.
3. The customers can scan the item's 2D Barcode / QR-code to ensure their authenticity.
4. Once the item is sold, the blockchain should mark the particular product as "sold"

If the product is authentic the application should provide all the details about the product along with the manufacturer, location of the manufacturer, distributor, location of the warehouse,



transportation companies and retailers. The application should also notify the user if the product is fake.

Web/App Dev

1. On-demand car service application

Travelling by automobile has been the most widely used mode of transport. Often while travelling, passengers face the situation of a vehicular breakdown. Passengers are unaware of the car service centres available at remote places.

Create a web/mobile app that will help connect passengers and mechanics when in need.

Suggestions :

- The web/app should support all vehicles like cars, buses or trucks, etc.
- It should display the nearby service centres/mechanics to the passengers.
- Passengers should get the contact information and the scope of service the centres/mechanics provide (Cost charges should be mentioned).
- Once a mechanic is hired by the passenger, a confirmation receipt along with the arrival time should be displayed.
- In case of failure of any mechanical parts of the vehicle, the passengers should have an option to purchase mechanical parts from nearby centres.

2. Course Tracker Companion

Students usually do not have access to resources related to the session they attend. Student's might also miss the session due to technical difficulties.

Create a course tracker that tracks a series of recorded lectures and assists students.

Suggestions :

The course tracker should provide functionalities such as:

- a. Ability to upload recorded lectures.
- b. The teacher should be able to attach lecture notes and references.

The system should be able to crawl the internet for resources to supplement the lecture.

The resources can be:

- Book references
- Academic and/or professional papers
- Tutorials and any other beneficial information.
