Such events allow volunteers to interact beyond their own college and provide them more exposure.


3. Quiz-a-thon

Volunteers used papers from old books to make handmade beautiful books for children from the NSS-UBA adopted villages. These books shall later be collected and taken to the villages.










8. Educational PPTs


9. Prayaas '21
