With reference to Point No 1: To read and approve the minutes of the last IQAC meeting.

Minutes of the last meeting held on 18/12/2021 were read and after due discussion it was approved by the members present.

With reference to Point No 2: To collect feedback from teachers for new syllabus.

As Mumbai University has introduced new syllabus for the Third-Year engineering students, so it was resolved to collect feedback from teachers for new syllabus. The questionnaire for the same were designed with the help of Principal Dr. G. T. Thampi. After discussion the questionnaire was approved. It was decided to create Google form for the same and collect the feedback.

With reference to Point No 3: To arrange guest lectures of alumni students.

It was resolved to arrange more guest lectures of TSEC alumni specially entrepreneurs, professors and subject matter experts (SME's) so that the students get new perspectives and opinions that are often missed in a regular class. Guest lecture also gives students a better opportunity to learn about an explicit topic in a way that gets them involved in the class and actively join in a more convenient way of teaching. Multiple webinars related to placements were conducted by our Alumni. It is further proposed to arrange multiple sessions with alumni related to higher studies guidance and industry needs. The guest lectures will be arranged by IQAC in coordination with the Head of the Departments.

With reference to Point No 4: Discussion on enhancing industry institute interaction.

Interaction between industry and institutes is critical for ensuring that practise meets theory across all functional domains. It helps a student's interpersonal skills and prepares him or her for the workforce. Interactions like these aren't necessarily restricted to case studies or internships.

Institutes may also organize industry-institute interaction activities such as panels and summits to bring together thinkers, experts, and practitioners so that students can benefit greatly from rigorous mentorship by passionate and highly dedicated industry personnel.


With reference to Point No 5: Review of FDP's/Code-storm/Hackathon/Workshops conducted during the year 2021-22.
