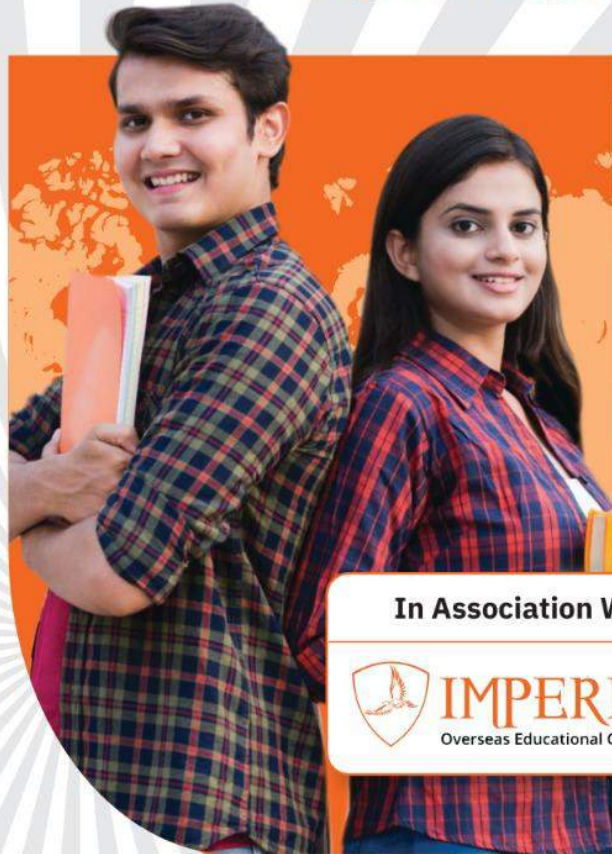
from guidance on choosing the right program to post-graduation opportunities.

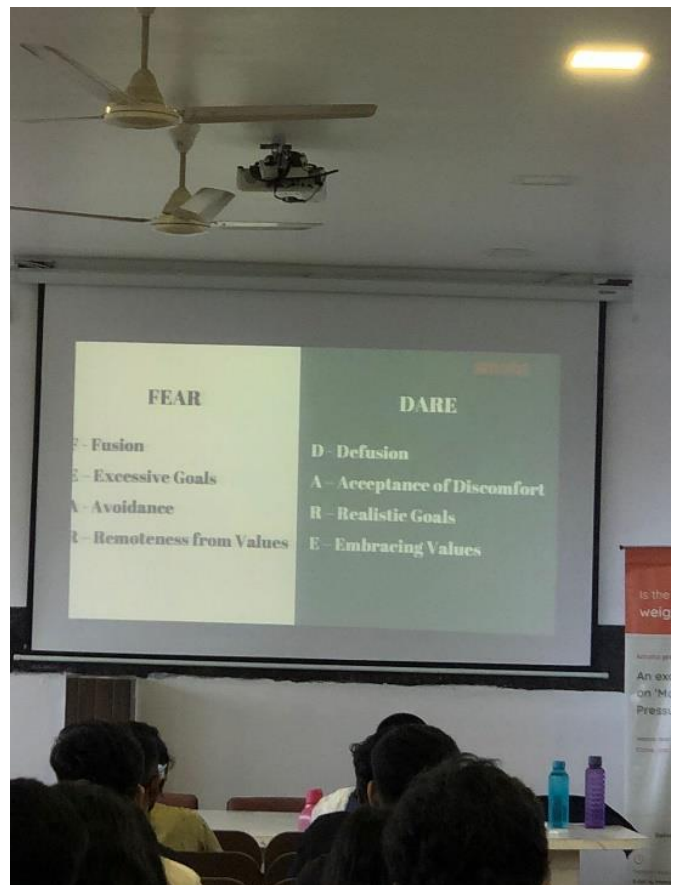

9th March, 2024 : The director started contacting various renowned personalities in the tech industry who would agree to be speakers for the event.

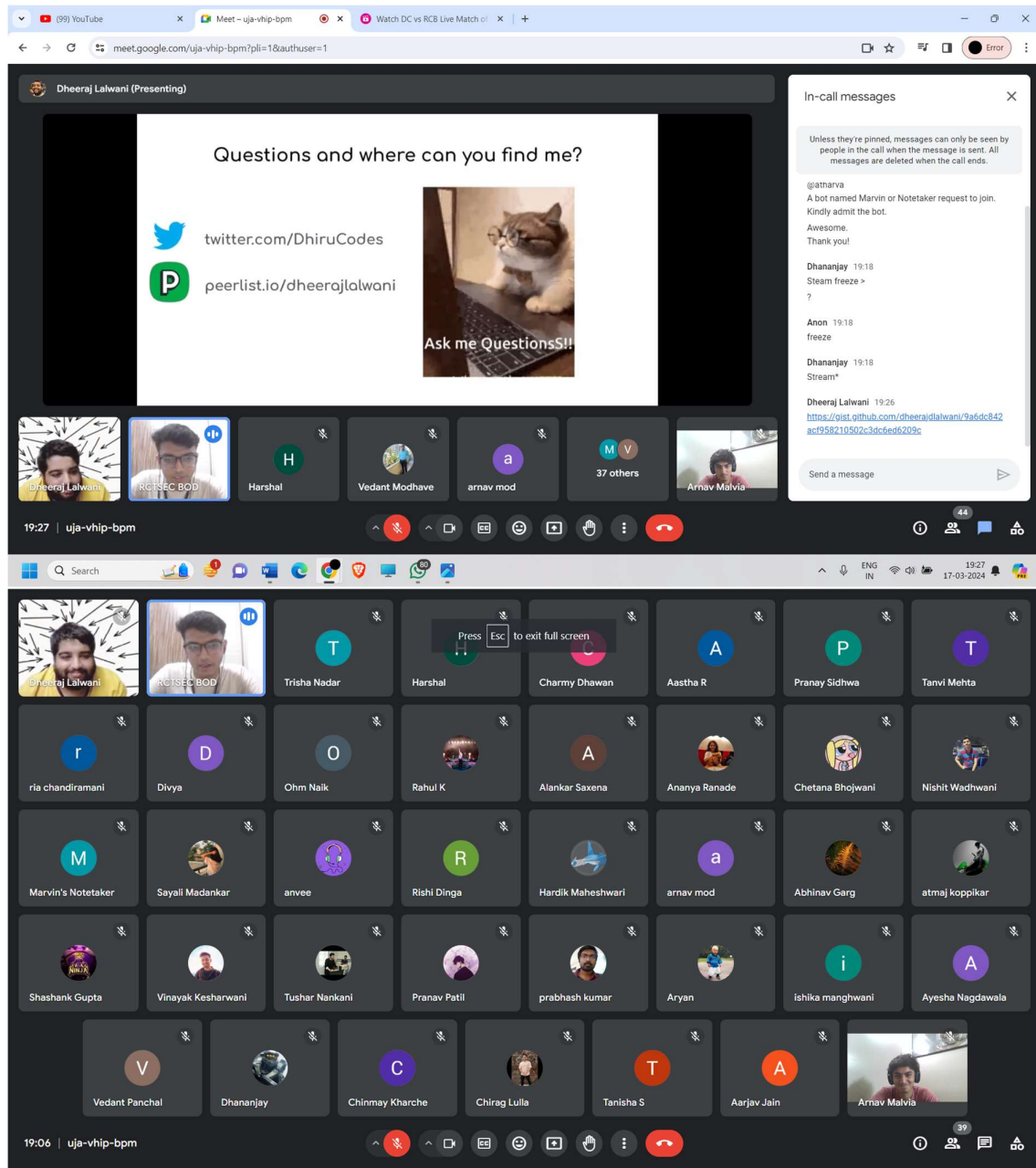
